Meeting Scheduling & Location

- There will not be a meeting in July, we will resume August 10, 2026.
- The group will continue meeting on the second Monday of each month. Meetings will continue in person with the option to attend virtually.

Approve Meeting Minutes

- Motion to approve May meeting minutes. Taunya 1st, Bryant 2nd, Motion Passed.
- Minutes will get uploaded on the website if they are missing. Christy will assist in passing them on to Anneliese.

Taunya (Special Events/Fundraising)

- Discussion on which fundraiser we plan to do next year. We will replace the Vertical Rise fundraiser with a direct donation fundraiser. We will start getting a direct drive flyer put together for each player during Captains practice and Breakdown. The form will include a QR code to donate via our Square account. We hope to hold the fundraiser in early November once teams are formed. The current plan is to have a goal of \$250 per player.
- We will also plan to do the spring concessions for the Youth State Tournament as we have in past years.
- Other ideas included a youth day of training at Shoot 360 led by the high school players. We also talked about selling the Kwik Trip carwash cards at some of our special event nights.

Social Media (Anneliese)

- Discussed ideas for new sponsorships. Last year we had \$6750 or our \$7500 goal. Anneliese though we need to increase the number of places we ask for sponsorships. We are also considering adding sponsorships for team dinner and warm up shirt sponsors.
- Jason confirmed that we can have logos on shooter shirts as long as they are not religious or political and are appropriate in nature.

- Anneliese sent an email with ideas for setting sponsorship levels for next year, the board needs to review the email and respond to Anneliese with input in the next week.
- Bryant will contact the Chamber of Commerce to get a list of local businesses so we can look into reaching out to a wider audience.
- Another idea was to have the players ask at their places of employment.
- We need to get our sponsor banner printed early and look at the placement in the gym. We also discussed getting some A frames to display sponsor information and logos at the gym entrance where game tickets are purchased for better visibility.

Kyla -

- We ordered warmup jackets for the current players for next year. The High School will pay the initial invoice and use the remaining high school balance (~2500) towards them and then the board will reimburse the remainder of the cost. We will place another order in the fall for the incoming 8th and 9th graders. We need delivery of the current order by June 30th.
- We also plan to order pants for all the players, but the current Nike pants in black were out of stock. Since we have used the remaining High School balance, the rest will be covered by the boosters and do not need to be ordered until the fall.

Special Events (Noni)

- The plan for next year is to have 4-6 pasta feeds or team dinners at the High School due to rides and convenience.
- We are hoping to tap into some local business to sponsor some of the team dinners, Ideas were Chipotle, Canes, and Carbones.
- The parents could sign up to cover beverages and/or desserts.
- Coach Wirtz will plan 2 all team events for next season. He plans to take the teams to Camp Courage again next season.
- Noni talked to the senior girls and they would like to have 4 special event nights next season. Senior Night/Youth Night/ Teacher Night/ and a Mental Health Night.
- We are tentatively planning to have the end of the year banquet at Dellwood on Thursday March 21.
- We also discussed having a "Day of Volunteering". We would plan a day for Summer/Fall/Winter for the players to get together and give back. The events would be organized for the players and they would participate as they could. Ideas included: Feed my Starving Children, filling a donation truck, the food shelf, finding a community member in need of yardwork.

Marie (Treasurer Report)

- Taxes are due at the end of September. Maria is working on them through the parent booster website. Bryant will make sure Maria has access to the parent booster website. All forms are available there. There is an 800 number to get assistance with the tax forms.
- Our account balance is strong at -\$17,000.

Jason Wirtz (Coach)

- Jason would like some booster \$ to purchase awards/prizes for summer basketball camp.
- We called a vote to allocate \$500 towards awards/prizes for summer basketball camp.
