Meeting Scheduling & Location

Approve Meeting Minutes

- Motion to approve June meeting minutes. Taunya 1st, Bryant 2nd, Motion Passed.
- Minutes will get uploaded on the website if they are missing. Christy will assist in passing them on to Anneliese.

Heather (Vice President)

- Discussed updating the website with current board information and approved meeting minutes. Anneliese is working on the website now and updating pictures etc for the upcoming season. Anneliese and Christy may try to get a second MFA working so Christy can help with website updates.
- Heather is going to coordinate and register the team for Fall Breakdown. Coach Wirtz talked to the team and they would like to play at STMA again this season. He will send Heather the dates and information so she can start the registration process.

Social Media (Anneliese)

- Anneliese presented the sponsorship levels and we all agreed upon the cost and benefits for each level. We added a shooter shirt sponsorship as the top level which includes all the platinum levels sponsorships in addition to having their logo on the players shooter shirts.
- Anneliese will send out an email with possible sponsors and a list who volunteered to reach out to each one.
- Taunya will create a square link to add to the sponsorship email to allow sponsors to pay via credit cards.

- We need to get our sponsor banner printed early and look at the placement in the gym. We also discussed getting some A frames to display sponsor information and logos at the gym entrance where game tickets are purchased for better visibility.
- Coach Wirtz said that the High School is standardizing banner size to 2"x3" for all sports.

Taunya (Special Events/Fundraising)

- Taunya is working on a direct drive letter for the players to distribute as a fundraiser. The form will include a QR code to donate via our Square account. We hope to hold the fundraiser in early November once teams are formed. The current plan is to have a goal of \$250 per player. She will have a letter for us to finalize at the next meeting.
- We will also plan to do the spring concessions for the Youth State Tournament as we have in past years.

Marie (Treasurer Report)

- Marie completed our 2025 taxes through the parent booster website.
- Our account balance is strong at -\$14,000.

Special Events (Noni)

- Coach Wirtz will plan 2 all team events for next season. He talked to the girls and is going to set up Camp Courage and a Karaoke Night.
- Noni talked to the senior girls and they would like to have 4 special event nights next season. We have a tentative date for each. Mental Health awareness- Dec 17. Teacher appreciation- Jan 8 or 14, Youth Night- Feb 5. Senior Night- Feb 11.
- Noni talked about partnering and donating to a new Mental Health organization this season. We discussed the possibility of printing our own shirts for the night.
- We are tentatively planning to have the end of the year banquet at Majestic Oaks on March 22nd. Dellwood did not have availability for the date we were looking at. Majestic Oaks had a larger space at a lower cost.
- Noni discussed a "Day of Volunteering" with the older players. They choose to do a Start School Strong event. We will get some signs made and purchase markers and chalk. The players will go out the weekend before school starts and put out motivation signs and chalk to welcome the returning students to school.
- We took a vote on funding \$400 for the Start School Strong event supplies. Bryant made the 1st motion, Christy 2nd, motion passed.

Bryant (President)

- Bryant talked to Shoot 360 about hosting a non school day youth camp. They agreed to host and asked if our Coaches would staff it or if we would like Shoot 360 Coaches to staff the event. Our players would volunteer to help at the camp. There would be a set camp registration fee and any profits above what Shoot 360 needs to run the event would go to the boosters.

- Bryant asked if Coach Wirtz is still planning to have a skills coach position paid for by the boosters this season. Coach Wirtz said that Coach Tom will move to being the full time Varsity Assistant Coach and Coach Rick will be the part time skill coach for as long as he is able to make the schedule work. He may only Coach through January.

Jason Wirtz (Coach)

- Coach Wirtz is planning to host a parents meeting the Wednesday before tryouts.
- Camp Courage will be on the first Saturday after teams are formed on November 21.
- CBA traveling tryouts will be 9/12-9/14.
